He was born in NY and worked in restaurants, pizzerias and delicatessens before graduating with a restaurant management degree and moving to Atlanta. After a few years working in restaurants in Atlanta, Seth and his partners started Moe's Southwest Grill. From his many trips to China town in NYC, there has always been a love for Asian cuisine, especially Dim Sum and great soups.

The vision of Lenny's is to provide the Overlook 2 tenants with a place to grab a great traditional American or Asian breakfast, cup of fresh locally roasted Dancing Goats coffee or housemade fresh baked pastries to start the day.
